This map illustrates the tactical positions of the Union and Confederate armies during the Second Battle of Bull Run on August 29, 1862. The Union forces, represented by red dashed lines and names, are positioned along Stony Ridge, Hill, and the Manassas Gap Railroad. Key Union units include Jackson, Lawton, Thomas, Gregg, Starke, Hood, Longstreet, D.R. Jones, Kempfer, Corse, Robertson, and Porter.
