- Hills:** STONY RIDGE, MATTHEWS HILL, DOGAN RIDGE, CHINN RIDGE, HENRY HILL, STUART'S HILL, Bald Hill.
- Roads:** Pageland Ln, Groveton Rd, Sudley Rd, Lewis Ln, Old Warrenton Rd, Manassas Gap RR, Manassas-Sudley Springs Rd, Warrenton Pike.
